Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry....

James 1:19b

How do you pray? When do you pray? What do you say?

Do you agree or disagree with the following statement?

**Sometimes the people with the most theologically impressive words live the least impressive lives - marriages and parenting.

5 "And when you pray, do not be like the hypocrites, for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the **street corners** to be seen by others. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full.

Don't be a hypocrite:

Say what they think others want them to say and only when others are watching.

Narrow streets mentioned in vs. 2. Widest (busiest) streets mentioned in verse 5.

Reward: Other people thinking you are 'super-spiritual'.

6 **But when you pray**, go into **your room**, **close the door** and pray to **your Father**, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

When you pray:

Go into your room and close the door.

Biblical postures of prayer:

— Kneeling (Daniel 6:10)— Lying on your face (prostrate) Jesus did that.

Standing - common Jewish custom.

Jews prayed at the third, sixth, ninth hour.

Pray to **the** Heavenly Father? No... pray to your Heavenly Father. — Don't pray to Jesus — Don't pray to his mother — Don't pray to the Holy Spirit 7 And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. 8 Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him. Matthew 6:5-8 **That you pray is more important than what you say. 1. The Pharisees Jews) prayer had become ritualistic. 2. The Pharisees' parade of piety. Rabbis: A long prayer is a 'heard' prayer. A recovered Jewish prayer - 16 adjectives before God. Reward: Your Heavenly Father knows? So... if God already knows, why pray? He is inviting us into a relationship. **Relationships don't happen in traffic? They can't be be 'cooked' in a microwave. (time, intentionality and focus) **Set your eyes on Jesus and listen well.
