**If you knew on December 31st of last year what you know about your life now....

Would you be proud of yourself? (Would you want this year to be exactly like last year?)

Discipline: Choosing what we want most more than what we want now.

**The second Friday of the new year (1/10/2025) is called guitters day.

When word came to Sanballat, Tobiah, Geshem the Arab and the rest of our enemies that I had rebuilt the wall and not a gap was left in it—though up to that time I had not set the doors in the gates— 2 Sanballat and Geshem sent me this message: "Come, let us meet together in one of the villages on the plain of Ono."

But they were scheming to harm me; 3 so I sent messengers to them with this reply: "I am carrying on a great project and cannot go down. Why should the work stop while I leave it and go down to you? Nehemiah 6:1-3

Theology of trying

**The reason most of us fail is because we've decided to try.

Trying is based on emotion and hope.

Training is based on commitment and expects and prepares for difficulty.

Training vs. Trying
